

NAME

`stats` - start and stop the stats package

SYNOPSIS

```
/usr/local/etc/local/stats/bin/stats {start|stop|force}
```

DESCRIPTION

The `stats` command starts and stops the `stats` package datacollectors and its databroker. The `stats` command does not activate changes made in the `stats` package configuration files. A `reconfigure services` is needed for that.

`start`

Start the `stats` package if needed. If all datacollectors and the databroker are running nothing is done. If one or more processes are not running, the running processes are killed and then all processes are started.

`stop`

Stops all datacollectors and the databroker.

`force`

Force a restart of the `stats` package. All running datacollectors and the databroker are killed. After that all datacollectors and the databroker are started.

DIAGNOSTICS

When no option or an invalid option is supplied, usage information is send to `STDOUT` and the command returns 1.

Information on stopping and starting is send to `STDOUT`.
