commandlist.xml - heartbeat package remote commands list format

SYNOPSIS

DESCRIPTION

The `heartbeat` package can schedule commands on the monitor and then execute them on the firewall. The `commandlist.xml` file specifies which commands are available and if they are enabled. In this way it isn't possible to execute a unspecified command. The available commands are in the `commands`-directory in the `heartbeat`-directory.

VARIABLES

The following variables are used in the `connectiontable.xml` file.

name

Name of the command used in the xml-packets.

program

Name of the executable for the command.

enabled

Enable/disable the command with YES or NO.

FILES

`/usr/local/etc/local/heartbeat/xml/commandlist.xml`
Location of the `commandlist.xml` file.
